#### **Course Description**

Cognitively impaired patients bring a set of challenges for the clinician that can compromise successful outcomes of the rehabilitation course... and create difficult challenges in the long-term care setting. Utilizing six dementia care levels, course participants will learn how to assess and treat functional deficits of the cognitively impaired older adult.<sup>1</sup> By the end of the session, participants will be able to quickly assess a patient's cognitive level (within 15 minutes of observation), as well as identify further in-depth assessment, documentation and treatment strategies.

This course encompasses an all-day training session utilizing lecture, video patient case studies, and small-group exercises incorporating practical application. The ideal course participant is a therapist (PT, OT, ST) working with patients diagnosed with dementia or related cognitive disorders.

#### **Continuing Education Units**

Participants will earn .7 continuing Education Units (CEUs) by attending this course. #### **Course Objectives**

Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:

1. Determine a patient's cognitive level of function following 15 minutes of observation.

3. Identify and document treatment goals appropriate for each stage of dementia.
4. Demonstrate successful treatment approaches and techniques for the patient with early-, middle- or late-stage dementia.
