For over 35 years, Marianjoy has been known for providing exceptional and compassionate acute rehabilitation care in the hospital setting. Now Marianjoy can offer the same high quality rehabilitation in a subacute setting – conveniently located on the 60 acre Wheaton campus.

Subacute care meets the need of those patients who are unable to withstand the intensity of acute rehabilitation therapy. It is also ideal for those patients who have completed our acute rehabilitation program, but still need to work toward their functional goals in order to go home. Responding to these patients needs, Marianjoy has established a new level of care that provides an integrated "link" between acute rehabilitation and home.

The new Marianjoy **RehabLink**[™] Subacute Center is located within Marianjoy Rehabilitation Hospital. This specialized transitional care center provides comprehensive subacute rehabilitation for patients who require an extensive hospital stay with a customized therapy plan that allows them to move to a higher level of independence with intensive rehabilitation. This multi-disciplinary program is designed to get individuals back home and performing many of the activities of daily life they engaged in before.

The Marianjoy **RehabLink**[™] Subacute Center is part of the comprehensive continuum of care offered by Marianjoy which also includes acute inpatient rehabilitation, outpatient physical therapy, and physician specialty clinics.

Marianjoy has been a pioneer in the subacute level of care for more than 20 years, working with and establishing partnerships with some of the area's leading skilled nursing facilities. As a leader in this level of care, the Marianjoy **RehabLink**[™] Subacute Center is available to provide:

- A patient and family-centered care team including nurses, therapists, case manager and physician working together toward the patient's functional goals
- Focused and efficient rehabilitation services that may include physical therapy, occupational therapy and speech therapy
- 24-hour nursing supervision
- Medical management led by a Marianjoy Medical Group board-certified physiatrist— a specialist in physical and rehabilitation medicine
- Meetings with the patient, family and the care team to discuss the patient's condition and progress
- Education for the patient and their family to successfully prepare to transition home or to another level of care
- Specialized orthopedic protocols

As a trusted partner during the rehabilitation process, Marianjoy delivers the intensity of services each patient needs— from general rehabilitation to the most complex level of care.

Acute Inpatient Rehabilitation

Marianjoy provides acute inpatient care to individuals requiring intensive rehabilitation and 24-hour hospital support. Our peaceful inpatient environment combines the medical expertise of our caring and compassionate staff with state-of-the-art technology to meet the therapeutic needs of each patient.

Subacute Inpatient Rehabilitation

Marianjoy provides subacute inpatient care to individuals requiring an extensive hospital stay with a customized therapy plan in our own 20 bed Marianjoy **RehabLink™** Subacute Center on the third floor of Marianjoy Rehabilitation Hospital in Wheaton.

In addition, Marianjoy has partnerships with some of the area's leading subacute skilled nursing facilities. Within the scope of subacute care, physicians, nurses, and therapists are available to meet both the medical and rehabilitation needs of all patients.

Outpatient Rehabilitation, Physical Therapy, and Other Services

Marianjoy outpatient adult and pediatric rehabilitation includes physical, occupational, and speech therapy, pain management, and driver rehabilitation. The scope and intensity of Marianjoy's outpatient services are designed to improve the patient's level of functioning based on the individual's needs and the referring physician's recommendations.



Staffed by a Team of Clinical Experts

The Marianjoy **RehabLink™** Subacute Center is staffed by a team of clinical experts including therapists and nurses who work under the direction of a Marianjoy Medical Group physiatrist. Together with input from the patient and family, the team determines the most effective and efficient treatment plan to help maximize the patient's independence. This plan is monitored and adjusted as needed throughout their stay.

The Marianjoy **RehabLink™** Subacute Center rehabilitation team includes:

Board-Certified Physiatrists: Medical management is provided by an on-site Marianjoy Medical Group physiatrist who is involved in assessing and monitoring the patient's ongoing care and addresses the modification of each patient's changing needs with the team.

Nursing Care: Rehabilitation nurses provide daily nursing care as well as 24-hour nursing supervision.

Therapy Team: A team of physical, occupational, and speech-language therapists work together to develop a comprehensive individualized treatment plan to meet the needs and goals of each patient.

Case Managers: A case manager is available to coordinate care and discharge planning for the patient.

Ongoing Relationship With Referring Physicians: Marianjoy works closely with referring physicians, including orthopedic and neurological physicians, to keep them informed of their patient's progress. All care plans and progress reports are shared with the patient's referring or primary care physician, to whom the patients are returned when they leave Marianjoy.

The Marianjoy **RehabLink™** Subacute Center accepts Medicare and most commercial insurance payments for patients that meet the admission criteria.



Compassionate Care in a Holistic Setting

The Marianjoy **RehabLink™** Subacute Center is located in Marianjoy Rehabilitation Hospital – an award-winning facility. Located on a 60-acre campus rich with ancient oaks, native prairie growth, and wildlife, the facility features an abundance of windows designed to create a warm and welcoming interior.

Private Rooms

Large private rooms provide patients and their families a tranquil, safe environment with floor-to-ceiling windows to view the campus environment. Other features designed for the comfort of patients and visitors include:

- Television with free access to movies, the Internet, music and educational videos
- Wheelchair accessible private bathrooms
- A sofa that converts into a sleeper for the comfort of family members
- A safe to secure personal items
- Telephone with free local phone calls
- Free convenient garage parking

Welcoming Lobby

The two-story main lobby is enhanced by a 15-foot water wall and stone fireplace, creating an inviting entrance that sets the tone for healing and serenity throughout the entire facility.

Enabling Garden

A central courtyard enabling garden gives patients the opportunity to enjoy the outdoors within the serenity of the hospital. Complete with soothing music and water features for sensory stimulation, patients can experience the healing effects of interacting with nature. Marianjoy patients can participate in horticultural therapy and practice navigating the various types of outdoor surfaces they will encounter once they return home.

Authentic Labyrinth

The centrally located labyrinth garden offers patients, families, and visitors the opportunity to use the labyrinth for meditation, therapy, and spiritual reflection. Built by renowned labyrinth expert Robert Ferré, it is an exact replica of the Chartres Cathedral labyrinth in France.

Two-Story Chapel

A two-story chapel incorporates handcrafted stained glass windows, inviting natural light to illuminate the room and provide a peaceful view of the wooded grounds.

Meditation Room

Available to both patients and visitors, a soundproof, softly lit meditation room promotes relaxation and centering. The room features a projected meditation mandala designed by expert Judith Cornell, Ph.D.

Ambient Music

To facilitate healing and promote stress reduction, music that has been customized for the hospital by music expert and author Don Campbell can be experienced in key areas of the facility.

Therapeutic Garden

Augmenting the expanded outpatient pavilion, a therapeutic garden incorporates walkways of various surfaces for patients and their therapists to practice real world challenges.
